




TRANSPORTATION Harman/Smith Bus


- Evacuation Drill Monday 9/9
- Buster the Bus Monday 9/9
- Reinforce good bus behavior: sit on bottom, stay in seat, hands and feet to self, use inside voice.
- No open food or drink on bus.
- 3 Strike Rule
 - 3 strikes = removal for one week
 - 3 removals = removal for remainder of school year

If Kettering AND Oakwood have 2-Hr Delay......


